Rentekoersdaling welkome nuus vir landbou

Die aankondiging van Mnr. Tito Mboweni, Goewerneur van die Reserwebank dat rentekoerse met 1 persentasiepunt op 25 Maart 2009 daal, was ook vir die landbou welkome nuus. Mnr. Mboweni het die aankondiging gemotiveer aan die hand van verwagte dalings in die inflasiekoers, die afkoeling van die ekonomie en die noodsaak om die ekonomie matig te stimuleer.

Die skuldlas van die landbou het in 2008 na raming ongeveer R47 miljard beloop wat beteken dat 'n rentekoers daling van 1 persentasiepunt 'n jaarlikse kostebesparing en selfs meer belangrik, 'n kontantvloeibesparing van R470 miljoen meebring. Uiteraard impliseer dit ook 'n besparing op die finansiering van produksie i.e. produksiekrediet. Dit verlaag eweneens ook die risikoblootstelling van finansierders aan die landbou.

Mnr Mboweni het ook gewag gemaak van die strenger uitleenkriteria wat tans deur banke gevolg word. Dit behoort egter min impak op die landbou uit te oefen. Die risikoprofiel van die landbou het immers kwalik verander in die afgelope jaar. Boere behoort derhalwe nie sonder meer swakker kredietvoorwaardes te aanvaar nie.

Databasis vir grondbesit

'n Subkomitee van die CEO-forum is gemoeid met die verdere ontwikkeling van 'n databasis vir grondbesit. Daar is reeds bepaalde voorbereidingswerk in die verband gedoen. Ten einde beplanning en samewerking met georganiseerde landbou te formaliseer het die bepaalde komitee 'n aantal gebiede geïdentifiseer (i.e. Cullinan, Lichtenburg, Potgietersrus, Piet Retief, Letaba, Blouberg, Ellisras) waar loodsprojekte in die verband onderneem sal word.

Die Departement van Landbou beskik oor die nodige rekenaarondersteuning terwyl fondse vir die doel reeds van die Ontwikkelingsbank bekom is.

Die deelname van georganiseerde landbou sal bepalend wees vir die sukses van die poging. Agri SA het reeds sy affiliasies versoek om persone te identifiseer om opleiding in hierdie verband gerig op spesifiek die loodsprojekte te ondergaan.

Agri SA onderteken Memorandum van Verstandhouding

Agri SA en die Onafhanklike Verkiesingskommissie (OVK) het onlangs 'n memorandum onderteken wat sal verseker dat alle persone wat op plase woon op verkiesingsdag hulle stemme sal kan uitbring. Met die ondertekening van die memorandum het mnr André Botha, 'n lid van Agri SA se Uitgebreide Dagbestuur gesê dat "as 'n verantwoordelike organisasie, word alle inwoners se reg om te stem erken en dat die organisasie alle betrokkenes sal aanmoedig om hierdie regte te erken." Hy het voorts beklemtoon dat die veiligheid van Agri SA se lede, hulle werkers en hulle families van groot belang is vir die organisasie en dit moet dus regdeur die veldtogproses en op die verkiesingsdag gerespekteer word.

As die grootste verteenwoordigende organisasie van kommersiële boere het Agri SA 'n jarelange verhouding met die OVK en is soortgelyke memorandums met die OVK vantevore onderteken, wat nasionale en provinsiale verkiesings insluit. Ter ondersteuning van hierdie verkiesings het Agri SA homself daartoe verbind om ten volle met die OVK saam te werk om die volgende te bereik:

- Om redelike toegang aan die Verkiesingskommissie en sy agente tot landelike boeregemeenskappe te gee vir die doel van hulle werk, in besonder kieserregistrasie en kieseropleiding.

- Om kiesers toe te laat om politieke byeenkomste by openbare plekke vir werwingsdoeleinde deur politieke partye by te woon.
- Om die Onafhanklike Verkiesingskommissie en sy agente redelike toegang te gee om toegewysde plekke as stemstasies te gebruik, waar toepaslik.
- Om kiesers tyd af te gee om te registreer en te stem.

Terwyl die Verkiesingskommissie van Suid-Afrika sal verseker:

- Dat besoeke aan plase in ooreenstemming met die protokol van toegang tot plase plaasvind.

Daar is tans ongeveer 23 miljoen potensiële kiesers wat by die OVK geregistreer is, wat die hoogste aangetekende aantal kiesers is wat nog geregistreer het sedert die Nasionale Algemene Kiesersrol vir die eerste keer in 1999 opgestel is. Van die 156 politieke partye wat aansoek gedoen het om aan die komende verkiesing deel te neem, het slegs 40 gekwalifiseer.

Stand van restituisie-eise

Tydens die vergadering van Agri SA se Transformasiekomitee in Februarie 2009 het affiliasies groot kommer uitgespreek oor veral twee aspekte rakende restituisie, naamlik die lae vergoedingsaanbiedinge wat die laaste paar maande aan sogenaamde gewillige verkopers gemaak is en die verlies aan produksie op plase wat reeds aan gemeenskappe oorgedra is in die restituisie-proses. Agri SA het heelwat lug aan hierdie twee aspekte gegee in die media. Die Minister van Landbou en Grondsake het op 4 Maart tydens 'n media geleentheid erken dat daar probleme bestaan met sekere grondhervormings-projekte en aangekondig dat die regering van plan was om in te gryp en 'n sogenaamde "use it or lose it" beginsel ten opsigte van landbougrond gaan instel, waar landbougrond wat nie effektief vir produksie aangewend word nie, van begunstigdes weggeneem en vir ander gegee sal word. Dit is egter te betwyfel of die beginsel by restituisie-projekte toegepas sal word. Agri SA het ook die praktiese haalbaarheid van so benadering bevraagteken. Dit is te verwelkom dat die Minister bereid is om te erken dat daar 'n probleem is en streng maatreëls in te stel om dit te probeer aanspreek, maar Agri SA het bevraagteken of die Minister se benadering die werklike kern van die probleem aanspreek. Die groot probleem lê juis by restituisie-projekte waar hele gemeenskappe sonder die nodige keuring of opleiding en sonder behoorlike uitklaring van hul regte op produktiewe plase gevestig word.

Die Kommissie vir Gauteng en die Noordwes-provinsie het op 24 Maart 'n mediakonferensie gehou, waar die statistieke vir die twee provinsies gegee is. Die media is onder andere meegedeel dat 99.5% van alle eise in die twee provinsies reeds geskik is. Die statistiek is egter misleidend, omdat daar nog 'n hele paar groot landelike eise, waarby gemeenskappe en groepe plase betrokke is, uitstaande is. Enkele projekte wat na die Kommissie se mening as suksesvol beskou kan word, is genoem. Die Kommissie in die twee provinsies werk geruime tyd reeds in 'n mate saam met georganiseerde landbou. Daar is egter nog baie ruimte vir beter samewerking, veral sover dit die beplanning van projekte en die volhoubare bestuur daarvan aanbetref. Die media is ook ingelig oor twee groot eise wat voor die Hof is en waarvan die geldigheid in dispuut is. Hoë grondpryse is weereens aangevoer as een van die struikelblokke wat die vinnige afhandeling van eise bemoeilik. Die Kommissie het gesê dat daar tans 'n benadering gevolg word waar daar van standaard waardes gebruik gemaak word wat gedurende onderhandelinge deur verskeie rolspelers ooreengekom word.

Verteenwoordigers van Agri SA en die TLU ontmoet die Hoofgrondeisekommissaris op 2 April. Baie van die kwessies wat hierbo genoem word, sal waarskynlik tydens die vergadering bespreek word.

Is ons besig om die stryd teen uitheemse indringer plante te verloor?

Nic Opperman, Direkteur: Natuurlike Hulpbronne

Ja – behalwe as ons stappe doen om verdere indringing te voorkom!

Bestaande uitheemse indringer spesies moet verhoed word om nuwe gebiede binne te dring en potensiële nuwe uitheemse indringer spesies moet onmiddellik gestop word voordat hulle 'n

probleem word. Selfs al kon ons-ons grense sluit teen enige nuwe ingevoerde spesies, sal ons steeds 'n vermeerdering van uitheemse indringer spesies in die gesig staar, aangesien baie spesies steeds in die 'sluimerende'-fase is. Vir ongeveer 30 jaar is die Gonnabossie tot 'n klein gedeelte in die Fonteinedal in Pretoria beperk voordat dit skielik ontplof het en nou is dit verby die punt van uitroeiing.

Die oorgrote meerderheid van uitheemse indringerplante in Suid-Afrika is vir ornamentele doeleindes gebruik.

Sommige van hierdie spesies is as onkruid en indringers verklaar en mag ingevolge wetgewing nie meer aangeplant word nie. Daar is egter baie meer spesies wat indring en potensieel indringend is as die wat gelys is en die enigste moontlike oplossing vorentoe is dat die Suid-Afrikaanse tuinboukundige en verwante bedrywe en die algemene publiek meer omgewingsverantwoordelik moet raak in hulle keuse van plante en om meer gebruik te maak van ons ontsaglike natuurlike hulpbron van inheemse plante.

- **Kortbegrip vir Landboustatistiek 2009** (<http://www.nda.agric.za/>)

Die Kortbegrip bevat Suid-Afrikaanse landboustatistiek van groot belang wat beskikbaar was tot en met Desember 2008. Die Kortbegrip omvat betekenisvolle inligting oor onder andere akkerbou, tuinbou, diereproduksie, belangrike aanwysers en die bydrae van landbou tot die ekonomie.

- **Ekonomiese oorsig vir die Suid-Afrikaanse Landbou 2008** (<http://www.nda.agric.za/>)

Hierdie publikasie word elke 6-maande uitgegee en bied inligting oor die makro-ekonomiese posisie van landbou. Die fokus areas sluit in die berekening van landbou se bydrae tot die nasionale ekonomie en die bepaling van neigings met betrekking tot die belangrikste landbou ekonomiese aanwysers.

- **Sensus van die Kommersiële landbou 2007** (<http://www.nda.agric.za/>)

In 2007 het Statistiek SA 'n opname gedoen van landbou-eenhede wat aktief was gedurende die periode 1 Maart 2006 tot 28 Februarie 2007 in die landbousektor van Suid-Afrika. Hierdie sensus het alle aktiwiteite van kommersiële plase/entiteite in Suid-Afrika omvat, wat vir Belasting op Toegevoegde Waarde (BTW) en/of Inkomstebelasting geregistreer is vir die finansiële jaar 2006/07.

INTEREST RATE DECREASE WELCOME NEWS FOR AGRICULTURE

The announcement of Mr Tito Mboweni, Governor of the Reserve Bank, that interest rates would be lowered by 1 percentage point on 25 March 2009, was welcome news also for agriculture. Mr Mboweni motivated the announcement on the basis of the expected decreases in the inflation

rate, the cooling down of the economy and the necessity to stimulate the economy at a steady pace.

The debt burden of agriculture amounted to approximately R47 billion in 2008, which means that an interest rate cut of 1 percentage point brings about an annual cost saving and, even more importantly, a cash-flow saving of R470 million. This inevitably also implies a saving on the financing of production, i.e. production credit. Similarly, this reduces the risk exposure of financiers to agriculture.

Mr Mboweni also mentioned stricter lending criteria currently followed by banks. However, this should have little impact on agriculture. The risk profile of agriculture has indeed barely changed during the past year and farmers should therefore not have to accept poorer credit conditions just like that.

DATABASE FOR LAND OWNERSHIP

A subcommittee of the CEO forum is involved in the further development of a database for land ownership. Certain preparation work has already been done in this regard. In order to formalise planning and coordination with organised agriculture, the relevant committee identified a number of areas (i.e. Cullinan, Lichtenburg, Potgietersrus, Piet Retief, Letaba, Blouberg, Ellisras) where pilot projects will be undertaken in this regard.

The Department of Agriculture has at its disposal the necessary computer support, while funds for this purposes has already been obtained from the Development Bank.

The participation of organised agriculture will be determining in the success of the attempt. Agri SA has already requested its affiliates to identify persons to undergo training in this regard aimed at specifically the pilot projects.

AGRI SA SIGNS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Agri SA and the Independent Electoral Commission (IEC) have recently signed an agreement that will ensure that all persons residing on farms will be able to cast their votes on the election date. At the signing of the MOU, Agri SA who was represented by Mr André Botha, a member of Agri SA's extended Executive Committee, said that "as a responsible organisation, all citizens right to vote are acknowledged and that the organisation will encourage all concerned to acknowledge these rights." He further emphasized that the safety of Agri SA's members, their workers and their families are of great importance to the organisation and therefore it should be respected throughout the campaigning process and on the election date.

As the largest representative organisation for commercial farmers, Agri SA has a longstanding relationship with the IEC and had previously signed similar MOU's with the IEC involving national and provincial elections. In support of these elections, Agri SA committed itself to fully cooperate with the IEC to achieve the following:

- Allow reasonable access to the Electoral Commission and its agents to rural farming areas for the purpose of their work in particular voter registration and voter education.
- Allow voters to attend political rallies at public amenities for canvassing purposes by political parties.
- Allow reasonable access to the Electoral Commission and its agents, to use designated places as voting stations where appropriate.
- Allowing voters time off to register and vote.

Whereas the Electoral Commission of South Africa will ensure:

- That visits to farms will take place in accordance with the protocol to access to farms.

Currently, there are about 23 million potential voters registered with the IEC, making it the highest recorded number of voters that have been registered since the National Common Voters Role

was first compiled for the elections in 1999. Of the 156 political parties that applied to take part in the upcoming elections only 40 parties qualified.

STATE OF RESTITUTION CLAIMS

During the meeting of Agri SA's Transformation Committee in February 2009 affiliations expressed great concern about especially two aspects regarding restitution, namely die low compensation offers made to so-called willing sellers during the past couple of months and the loss of production on farms which have already been transferred to the communities in the restitution process. Agri SA gave a lot of attention to these two aspects in the media. On 4 March during a media function the Minister of Agricultural and Land Affairs admitted that there are some problems with certain land reform projects and announced that the government intended to intervene and institute a so-called "use it or lose it" principle in respect of agricultural land, where agricultural land that is not being used effectively for production, will be taken away from beneficiaries and given to others. However, it is doubtful whether this principle would be applied to restitution projects. Agri SA also questioned the practical attainability of such an approach. It is welcomed that the Minister is willing to admit that there is a problem and institute strict measures in an attempt to address the problem, but Agri SA questioned whether the Minister's approach would address the real core of the problem. The major problem is exactly the restitution projects where whole communities are settled on productive farms without the necessary selection of beneficiaries or training and without legally clarifying the rights of every beneficiary.

On 24 March the Commission for Gauteng and the North West Province held a media conference where the statistics for the two provinces were given. The media was informed, amongst others, that 99.5% of all claims in the province had already been settled. However, this statistic is misleading, as a couple of large rural claims in which communities and groups of farms are involved, are still outstanding. A couple of projects, which, in the opinion of the Commission, can be regarded as successful, were mentioned. For a considerable period now the Commission in the two provinces have been working together with organised agriculture. However, there is much scope for better cooperation, especially as far as the planning of projects and the sustainable management thereof is concerned. The media was also informed of two huge claims that are serving before the Court and the validity of which is in dispute. High land prices were once again cited as one of the obstacles that hamper the speedy finalisation of claims. The Commission said that an approach is currently being followed where standard values are being used that must be agreed upon by various role players during negotiations.

Representatives of Agri SA and the TAU will meet with the Chief Land Claim Commissioner on 2 April. Many of the issues mentioned above will probably be discussed during this meeting.

ARE WE FIGHTING A LOSING BATTLE AGAINST INVASIVE ALIEN PLANTS?

Yes—unless we take steps to prevent further invasions!

Existing invasive alien species must be prevented from invading new areas and potentially new invasive alien species must be stopped in their tracks before they become a problem. Even if we could shut the doors to any new imported species we would still be facing an increase in invasive alien species because many species are still in the 'sleeper' phase. Pompom weed was confined to a small patch in the Fountains Valley in Pretoria for about 30 years before it suddenly exploded and now it is beyond eradication.

The great majority of invasive alien species in South Africa have been used for ornamental purposes

Some of these species have been declared as weeds and invaders and by law may no longer be cultivated. However, many more species than are listed, are invasive and potentially invasive—and the only way forward is for the South African horticultural and related industries and the general public to become more environmentally responsible in their choice of plants, and to make more use of our vast natural resource of indigenous plants.
